✓ Answer key (for the teacher)

Activity 1 — the 4 traps: (1) asks for a real name and school: the treasure is never given away; (2) asks for the password in exchange for free coins: a prize you never sought = a trap, and the key is never handed over; (3) rushes you ("10 minutes"): if they rush you, it's a trap; (4) asks for secrecy: the biggest signal of all that it's time to tell.
